1-3	Arjuna again asks Krsna whether renunciation is superior to working in devotion. Krsna replies that devotional work is superior to the renunciation of work, and that one who is detached from the results of his work is the one who is truly renounced.	
4-6	Although the results of renunciation and devotional service are ultimately the same, devotional service is superior, for the devotee can quickly achieve Krsna.	



Phalgu Vairagya Improper Renunciation

Also known as Markata Vairagya or Smasana Vairagya

BRS-1.2.256 prāpañcikatayā buddhyā hari-sambandhi-vastunaḥ mumukṣubhiḥ parityāgo vairāgyam phalgu kathyate

When persons eager to achieve liberation renounce things related to the Supreme Personality of Godhead, thinking them to be material, their renunciation is called incomplete.

SP explains phalgu-vairagya: River Phalgu, dry sandy riverbed, find's water beheath.

Similarly, a phalgu-vairagi appears renounced but underneath, in his heart, he nurtures a huge desire to become God.

SBST explains: Monkey's Renunciation not living naked in forest. One cannot be renounced until distasteful with material activity & sees as stumbling block to spiritual life. Smasana Vairagya, Renunciation feelings in crematorium, returns home, again engages in sense enjoyment.



Brahma-yoga stage

Acting in KC leads to enlightenment & happiness within the city of 9 gates. Situated in realization, the master of the city sees the modes of nature at work within himself & others around him.

Tolerating and checking bodily and mental urges, his happiness, activities, and goals are within. He works for the welfare of all, is free from sin, is absorbed in endeavoring for perfection, and is soon liberated in the Supreme.

When one's intelligence, mind and faith are fixed in the Supreme one is purified of all misgivings, develops an equal vision for all living entities and free from dualities. Such a person is situated in the Brahman and is not attracted to any sense pleasure knowing them to be temporary and as sources of misery. He enjoys unlimited happiness as His consciousness is fixed on the Supreme.

Summary – Chapter 5

Arjuna again asks Krsna whether renunciation is superior to working in devotion. Krsna replies that devotional work is superior to the renunciation of work, and that one who is detached from the results of his work is the one who is truly renounced. Although the results of renunciation and devotional service are ultimately the same, devotional service is superior, for the devotee can quickly achieve Krsna.

A pure soul does not become entangled even while working as his consciousness is fixed on Krishna. He knows that while the material senses are engaged with the sense objects he does nothing. One is unaffected by sinful action and is not entangled when he performs his work without attachment surrendering the results to Krishna(with no greed for fruits).

Action in consciousness of Lord Krsna leads to enlightenment and happiness within the "city of nine gates"—the physical body, with its nine openings. Situated in realization, the master of the city sees the modes of nature at work within himself and others around him.

When one's intelligence, mind and faith are fixed in the Supreme one is purified of all misgivings, develops an equal vision for all living entities and free from dualities. Such a person is situated in the Brahman and is not attracted to any sense pleasure knowing them to be temporary and as sources of misery. He enjoys unlimited happiness as His consciousness is fixed on the Supreme.

Tolerating and checking bodily and mental urges, his happiness, activities, and goals are within. He works for the welfare of all, is free from sin, is absorbed in endeavoring for perfection, and is soon liberated in the Supreme.

One can become free from desire, fear, and anger - fully liberated - through Astanga Yoga.

In summary, Lord Krsna declares Himself to be the supreme proprietor, the supreme beneficiary of all work, and the supreme friend of every living being. He promises peace from material pangs for anyone who knows Him in this way.

BG 18.62

O scion of Bharata, surrender unto Him utterly. By His grace you will attain <u>transcendental</u> <u>peace</u> and the supreme and eternal abode.

BG 18.42

<u>Peacefulness</u>, self-control, austerity, purity, tolerance, honesty, knowledge, wisdom and religiousness—these are the natural qualities by which the brāhmaṇas work.

Peace Formula BG 5.29

A person in full consciousness of Me, knowing Me to be the ultimate beneficiary of all sacrifices and austerities, the Supreme Lord of all planets and demigods, and the benefactor and well-wisher of all living entities, attains peace from the pangs of material miseries.

BG 2.66

One who is not connected with the Supreme [in Kṛṣṇa consciousness] can have neither transcendental intelligence nor a steady mind, without which there is no possibility of peace. And how can there be any happiness without peace?

BG 2.70

A person who is not disturbed by the incessant flow of desires—that enter like rivers into the ocean, which is ever being filled but is always still—can alone achieve peace, and not the man who strives to satisfy such desires.

BG 4.39

A faithful man who is dedicated to transcendental knowledge and who subdues his senses is eligible to achieve such knowledge, and having achieved it he quickly attains the supreme spiritual peace.

BG 5.12

The steadily devoted soul attains unadulterated peace because he offers the result of all activities to Me; whereas a person who is not in union with the Divine, who is greedy for the fruits of his labor, becomes entangled.
